### Nature's Rhythm

Forms and shapes, abstract and minimalist, symbols of freedom, elation, and the perpetual journey. Hand-molded ceramics in white and blue color, rhythmic forms that playfully move with intimacy and tension against light and shadows that morph into new formations.

Ceramic forms, invoking the movement of the waves, flocks of birds flying overhead, schools of fish sweeping in synchrony through deep blue sea. Sculptures inspired by the fins, tails and feathers, formed by the clay, a material used since ancient times in our homeland that bridges our history and tradition with the modern present.

Merged with other materials, glass and metal, each sculpture travels in perpetual movement representative of our quest constant for freedom and harmony.

#### VARAVARA GEORGIOU

She was born in Nicosia, Cyprus, in 1961. She studied Art and Design at Croydon College of Design and Technology and Three-Dimensional Design at Middlesex University, London.

She exhibited her work in many personal and group exhibitions. Her work can be found in the Cyprus Ministry of Education and Culture, Marfin Laiki Bank Cultural Centre, Bank of Cyprus Cultural Foundation, Central Bank of Cyprus, Municipal Gallery of Limassol, Paphos International Airport, Strovolos Municipality Building, Hilton Park Hotel in Nicosia, the United Kingdom the Cyprus Tourism Organisation offices in London and in many private collections.

She represented Cyprus at the Biennale New European Countries in Bologna in 1998, in Marseille in 1990 and in Cairo in 1998. She also participated in Modern Cypriot Art exhibitions organised by the Ministry of Education and Culture in Kuwait and Bulgaria in 1990, at the Cyprus Cultural Centre in London in 1991, at the Cyprus House in Athens in 1994, in Salonica: Cultural Capital of Europe in 1997 and the Salonica Old Archaeological Museum in 2006, and in Mexico City in 2016.
